


## TRASH Take Responsibility and Show How Science4Society Week 2020 competition



The theme of 2020 S4S Week is tackling waste and pollution in their many forms. We've focused on reducing emissions that pollute the air, water or land; reducing the waste we throw away; or reducing our 'carbon footprint'. So, think about the food we eat, the energy we use in our homes or schools, where we travel to and how we travel, and the stuff we buy or throw away and how we can improve this.

Can you give an example of how you have taken responsibility and tackled pollution or waste in some way – at home, at school, in your community. This could be on your own or in a group or class. How can you demonstrate that you have made a difference? Has the air quality improved in your street? Has the amount of waste in your school gone down? Has your carbon footprint reduced because you now eat less meat and dairy, cycle to school or simply buy less stuff?

Your entry must answer these questions and could be in **any form**, including:

- Poster
- Film (5 minutes max)
- Essay (500 words max)
- Presentation (5 slides max)
